

CBC Coaches Contract

The mission of the Church Basketball for Christ is to glorify our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ through the fellowship of basketball. Teaching the players the importance of:

- 1) Working as a team
- 2) Listening to the Coach
- 3) Dealing with adversity
- 4) Losing with dignity and winning with grace
- 5) Respecting and honoring the opponent

As a **coach**, you represent the league to the Easley/Wren community. The effectiveness of this ministry rests in large part to your spirit in times of difficulty. Your ability to teach, encourage and apply the above behaviors yourself.

All **coaches** are expected to review:

- league rules (Hoops4christ.com/docs/Rules2015.pdf)
- divisional rules (hoops4christ.com/docs/BasketballQuickRuleSheet2015.pdf).

As **coaches**, your accountability includes the following:

- 1) Ensure behaviors and actions toward the referees, opposing coaches and players, and the gym personnel honor the Lord. This includes the shaking of hands after a game. Any concerns or comments should be handled in a diplomatic, respectful and private manner.
- 2) Ensure your church fans, parents and players exhibit self-control and an encouraging spirit throughout the game. Any incidents with fans or players during and immediately after the game are the responsibility of the coach to resolve.
- 3) When one team begins to dominate a game (by score and physicality), the coach should demonstrate constraint and mercy. Options include more substitutions, reducing the offensive and defensive intensity, etc.
- 4) The length of player shorts in front and to the side must be 1-inch below a player's fingertips. For females, sports bras and underclothes must not be visible.
- 5) Uniform rules are not negotiable before a game. No tape or other temporary numbers allowed.
